Uniform Consultation

Thank you to all who took the time to respond to our recent consultation on school uniform. The responses will be collected together for discussion and consideration by our school's Board of Governors. Our current uniform policy remains in place:

Full Uniform: pale blue shirt, school tie, navy V-neck jumper, black shoes

Girls—grey skirt/pinafore, white socks/grey tights, navy hair accessories

Boys—Grey trousers, grey socks

PE Uniform: red polo shirt, navy shorts/leggings/jogging bottoms, navy V-neck jumper, trainers

Nursery

Our Nursery Unit has been accepted onto the pre-school standardisation programme. This will result in the hours increasing from 2.5 hours per day to 4.5 per day from September 2025, with a mid-day meal being provided.

Winter Weather

As the colder weather is now with us, we would like to remind all parents to ensure that children have a coat with them each day and possibly a hat, scarf and gloves. On snow days, pupils should bring a change of clothes, snowboots/wellie boots and a change of socks. On snowy and icy mornings, priority will be given to clearing the pathways at the front of the school, including to the Nursery entrance, the main school entrance and the front classroom doors. Yrs 1—4 should access the school via the front classroom doors on such mornings. Please take care when accessing the school premises on such days.

Should school be required to close in any exceptional circumstances, parents will be informed via a text message, our social media channels and the school website. When necessary, a phone call to parents/guardians will also be made.
